Our Staff

Head Coach Jeff Sziksai is entering his 8th year at the helm of the LMU baseball program, and his 12th year in college coaching. During that span, Sziksai has taken the program from 5 wins in 2003, to back to back to back 30 win seasons, while making four appearances in the national top 30. Before coming to LMU, Sziksai spent four years as an assistant coach at Division I programs Western Carolina University, and Old Dominion University. As a player, coach Sziksai was an infielder at Western Carolina University before being drafted by the New York Yankees in the 1998 draft.

Assistant Coach Ryan Schmalz is entering his 6th season with the LMU baseball program. Primarily working with the hitters, Schmalz's 2007 hitters led the South Atlantic Conference in hitting, and have ranked third or better on three other occasions. Prior to coming to LMU, Schmalz spent two years at D1 Morehead State University as an assistant coach. Schmalz's playing career at Olivet Nazarene saw him lead his team to two appearances to the NAIA World Series.

Assistant Coach Tate McMillan is entering his second season with the Railsplitters. Coach McMillan joins the staff after playing 1B and catcher at NCAA Division I Tennessee Tech from 2006-2010.

LMU Prospect Hitting Camp

The LMU Prospect Hitting Camp is designed to teach both the fundamentals of hitting as well as the mental approach to hitting. Our intense 2-day camp will include station work, live batting practice, video breakdown and analysis, personalized instruction from the LMU staff and a final report card of that prospect's skills.

LMU Prospect P/C/INF Camp

The LMU P/C/INF Camp is designed to teach the fundamental concepts of pitching, catching or infield play. **(The camper will choose one position. You will not be taught all three positions.)**

Pitching- will include station work to teach proper mechanics, video breakdown and analysis, a conditioning and strength lecture, and a final report card of that prospect's skills.

Catching Camp- will focus on fundamental techniques of blocking, receiving, throwing, footwork, calling pitches and handling pitchers. It will also include video evaluation and breakdown, a strength and conditioning lecture, and a final report card of that prospect's skills.

Infield Camp- will focus on fielding technique, body position, footwork, double play feeds, relays and positioning.

Facilities

Camp will be held at the indoor facilities in Tex Turner Arena, and Mary Mars Gymnasium on the campus of LMU. Local HS indoor facilities will also be utilized. Weather permitting, some portions of the camp will be held on Lamar Hennon Field.
